Signing Ceremony for agreement between Chiba University and Fudan University in Shanghai, China

On November 21, 2017, Dr. Takeshi Tokuhisa, President of Chiba University visited Fudan University for a signing ceremony to conclude the university-level agreement. And then Prof. Nobue Nakamura, Dean, Graduate School of Nursing signed the faculty-level agreement between School of Nursing, Fudan University and School of Nursing and Graduate School of Nursing, Chiba University.

Fudan University was founded in 1905. It is one of the most prestigious and selective universities in China and a member in the C9 League. Fudan confers bachelor's degrees in 70 academic disciplines and graduate degrees in 225 fields.
